

How To: Enable Single Sign On For Web App Login

Single Sign On (SSO) can be enabled for enterprise customers to use one account for your domain when logging into **Onsight Platform Manager** (OPM) and **Onsight Connect for Web App**. The benefits of SSO are:

- No need to type in credentials
- No need to remember/renew passwords
- No weak passwords



Note: SSO must be enabled for your account by your system administrator.

In order to enable single sign on, you will need to launch an approved web browser and access the **Onsight Connect for Web** (https://connect.onsight.librestream.com) on your device and:

- 1. Click the **Sign in with SSO** option.
- 2. Enter your **Company Domain** information and click **Login**.
- 3. Enter your login credentials within the **Identity Provider** and click **Sign In**.



Tip: Click the **Need help signing in?** link if you encounter any challenges.

Enabling SSO for Web App

In this task, you will enable SSO for the Web App. To enable SSO, you must:

1. Launch a web browser and access the Web App.

2. Click the Sign in with SSO link near the bottom. The Sign in with SSO window appears.

- 3. Enter your Company's Domain address within the Company Domain field. For example, enter Acme.com.
- 4. Click Login.




Figure 5. Identity Provider Sign In

- 5. The **Identity Provider > Sign in** window appears. Enter your:
 - a. Username
 - b. Password
 - c. Enable the Remember me check box to automate and speed-up the login process.
- 6. Click Sign in.

This completes the procedure.



SSO Web App — Login-Settings

Once you have logged in using SSO, your saved login settings are accessible from the main menu bar by clicking **More Actions > Settings > My Profile**. My profile includes the following read-only fields:

- Username
- First Name
- Last Name
- **SIP** information that includes your **Identity Provider** (IDP):
 - Server Address
 - URI




Figure 6. SSO Saved Login Settings
