

ONSIGHT HOW TO:

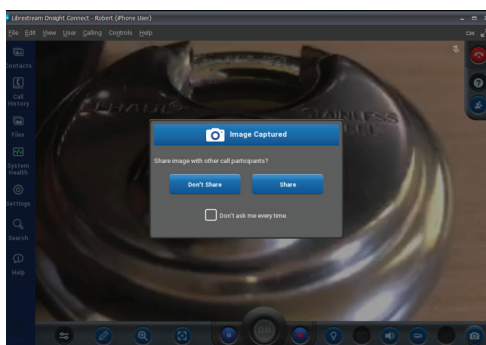
TAKE A HIGH-RES SNAPSHOT with V 9.1

Follow these steps once you log in to Onsight Connect and establish an Onsight call:

Step 1: Start streaming video. Next, pause the video stream and take a remote snapshot using the Snapshot button.



Step 2: When the snapshot is taken, the **Image Captured** message will display. The message will give you the option to either share or not share the image with participants on the call.

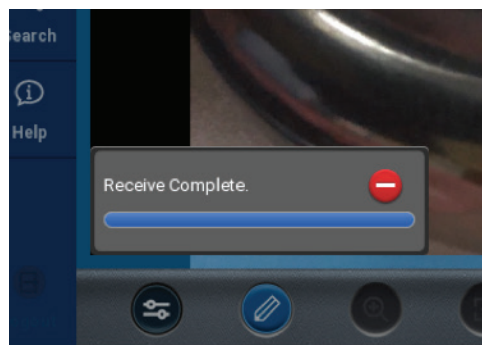


Step 3: If you decide to **share** the image and if the video source has high-res capabilities for image taking, the Snapshot button will change to a button referred to as the **High-Res Image Transfer Button**.



Clicking the **High-Res Image Transfer Button** shares the high-resolution image with all participants on the call.

Step 4: Once completed, Onsight will provide a message indicating that **all** participants have received the High-Res image. The High-Res image will be saved in **Files > My Files**.



The type of Hi-Res image created is **dependent on the device**. If the camera has 4K video capabilities, Onsight can capture images at resolutions higher than 1080 pixels. You can find your resolution capabilities in the device manual.
